Proceedings of Joint Meeting of IQAC and PG departments held on 28.08.2015 at 2.30 pm

Dr. C.S. Mukherjee, IQAC coordinator presided over the meeting. IQAC members and PG faculty members were present.

As per the suggestions of the meeting of IQAC held on 24.08.2015, IQAC coordinator read out the recommendations of NAAC during the visit 10-12 March, 2014. He also reported the suggestion of Prof. Suranjan Das, V.C. of Jadavpur University regarding the activities of PG departments. Emphasis was given on Research activities, Research Publications in Peer Reviewed Journals with high impact factor, Summer & Winter School for faculty members, Industrial visits, collaborations with industries and Research Institutes, Consultancy, Faculty exchange etc. The members considered this.

Smt. Rama Das proposed that the dept. of Food & Nutrition will offer consultancy services to ICDS centers and local clinics.

Dr. Sutripta Sarkar raised the issue that management appointee teachers face problem regarding sponsorship from different agencies.

Dr. Swati Roy Gangopadhyay reported that in past days college appointed fulltime teachers received grants from CSIR while Smt. Susmita Roy reported that there were problem of sponsoring funds for college appointee teachers.

IQAC coordinator proposed that a letter be written to UGC, CSIR, DBT & other sponsoring agencies requesting them to highlight the eligibility criteria to avail of the grants from this agencies.

Smt. Pinki Mondal and Smt. Satarupa Dey Neogi ^{raised} ~~resided~~ the issue of reimbursement of registration fees from the college fund for paper presentation in national and international seminars.

Sri Arijit Chaudhuri proposed the following

- a) PG Courses be opened in those departments which run UG courses and which have satisfactory infrastructure.
- b) The Microbiology department is going to introduce CBCS and accordingly reform in PG syllabus is needed.
- c) The department has resolved to organised a seven ^{day} ~~a~~ workshop funded by UGC
- d) Department proposes to start a departmental journal.

- e) Department is going to introduce Industrial visit in PG courses as demanded by the PG students and reflected in Students Feedback.

Sri Dipankar Majumder proposed that arrangements be made for standardization of departmental laboratory from the Bureau of Indian standards to conduct certain specific test.

All PG departments strongly proposed for a Controller Section.

Most of the lab based departments raised the problem of large intake in honours section, shortage of non-teaching staff, non-availability of Lab. Attendant at the start of the lab and after 5.00 pm.

Sri Arindom Chakraborty (officiating Head Clerk) considered the problem and proposed that measures be taken solve the problem.

Most of the departments raised problem of non-availability of internet and as a result the faculty members are not getting advantage in Research related matter.

IQAC Coordinator and Arindom Chakraborty assured that the problem be solved at an early date.


Dr. Abhijit Kundu proposed that the affiliating university (West Bengal State University) be approached for recognition of College Research Centers.
