The Venue

arrackpore, spelled Barrackpur or Barakpur at times, is located in the south-eastern part of the state of West Bengal. It constitutes the oldest Cantonment in India. The name of the cantonment is probably derived from the word 'barrack', there having been troops stationed here since 1772. In 1824 Indian troops stationed in Barrackpore refused to participate in a mission during the First Anglo -Burmese War (1824-26). It was also in Barrackpore that the mutinous actions of a sepoy, Mangal Pandey, in March 1857, came to be regarded as the first event in a growing series of anti-British acts that culminated in the great Sepoy Mutiny. Barrackpore Park contains the former suburban residence of the British viceroy of India. The city is also the site of Central Inland Capture Fisheries Research Institute, the oldest organization of its kind in India.

The College

arrackpore Rastraguru Surendranath College was established in 1953 in the historical town of Barrackpore, situated in the East bank of the river Ganges. It is among the very few colleges in the state to be awarded as 'College with Potential for Excellence' by UGC. It was formerly affiliated to the University of Calcutta and is presently affiliated to the West Bengal State University. Over the years the college has consolidated its position as a premier institution in the state of West Bengal imparting knowledge in the diverse fields of Humanities, Commerce and Basic Sciences. It is a NAAC 4th Cycle re-accredited 'B++' Grade college with the privilege of being the first college in the state to have completed the 4th cycle of accreditation. Moreover, the Library is subscribing IEEE, Sage Journals in electronic forms. The Library is a part of NPTel (National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning), an initiative of IITs & IISc to enhance the quality of education in the country by developing curriculum based video and web courses. The Library is Institutional Member of BCL, Kolkata. There are Departmental Libraries in each department for catering to the academic needs of the students of concerned departments.
