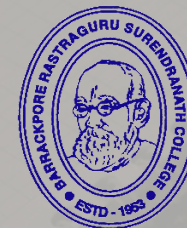

The College

Barrackpore Rastraguru Surendranath College, founded in 1953, is a UGC registered College [under 2f] & accredited by NAAC. A group of dedicated men, led by Dr. Satish Bose, a noted social worker, took the initiative in establishing this institution on 19 Sept. 1953 and named it after one of the most illustrious sons of Barrackpore and India. The institution initially functioned from Debiprasad High School and in 1954 was shifted to 6 Riverside Road as an institution affiliated to the University of Calcutta. In 1969, the college expanded with a new plot at 85 Middle Road. From the session 2008-09, the college will be affiliated to the West Bengal State University, Barasat as per government Gazette. The College is accredited (4th Cycle) by NAAC and have College with Potential for Excellence status by UGC.

Presently the College runs 22 UG, 8 autonomous PG and 5 certificate courses with 6000+ students. Apart from the traditional education, the College also pays endeavour towards growing human values and ethics among the students by encouraging them to participate in programmes related to society, environment, wild life etc.

The IQAC

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the College plays an important role to overall quality development and sustenance. The Cell acts according to the guidelines of University Grants Commission and National Assessment and Accreditation Council. All major decisions on

development, infrastructure, financial management, academic affairs, admission, governance and administration are taken by the Governing Body in line with recommendations and suggestions of IQAC and various statutory and non-statutory sub-committees.

The IQAC acts as the nodal agency in promoting quality culture and sustaining development activities in the institution. It takes multifarious initiatives round the year to achieve quality benchmarks in the activities of the institution.

Till date the College has been accredited by NAAC four times since 2004. The College also achieve the UGC CPE status with the active contribution of the IQAC.

The Central Library

The Central Library is computerized with around 62,000 printed documents and 46 regular journals and magazines. The library is automated with open source software Koha. The catalogue of entire collection of the library is available 24X7 remotely through the WebOPAC powered by Koha. The circulation system is powered with RFID technology. The Library is member of N - LIST (National Library and Information Services infrastructure for Scholarly Content) consortium of INFLIBNET through which the members of the library can access 6300+ ejournals and 1,00,000 ebooks. More over the Library is subscribing IEEE Journals in electronic forms. The Library is a part of NPTEL (National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning), an initiative of IITs & IISc to enhance the quality of education in the country by developing curriculum based video and web courses.
